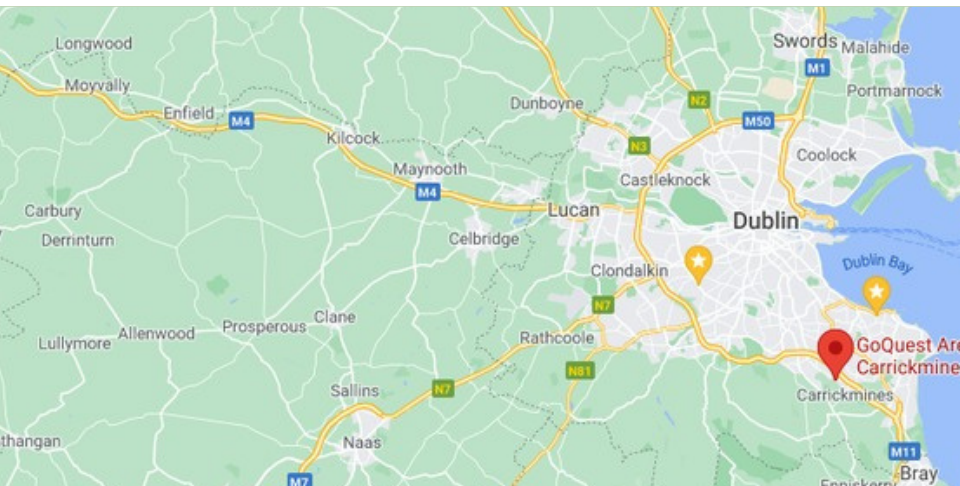
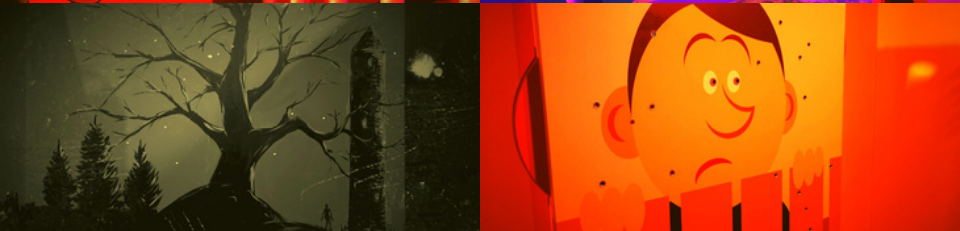

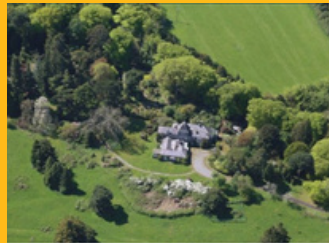


### Fernhill Gardens (8 mins drive)
